

Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) Tenant Eligibility Checklist

New Hampshire Housing must receive the following information for each applicant.

Marketing declaration form-completed and signed within the last 60 days
Citizenship Verification form for each family member
Social Security number for each household member
Signed HUD 9886 for all family members over 18.
Signed New Hampshire Housing Release for all family members over 18
years.
HUD 52675-Debts owed for each family member 18 years and over
Signed NH Criminal release form for each adult hh member
(If applicable) Signed Out of state criminal release form for each adult hh
member

If the applicant has access to the following documents, provide with the application. Otherwise, they will need to supply them to NH Housing within 90 days of being admitted to the program.

Social Security card for each household member
Copy of Birth certificates for each family member.
If an applicant does not have a copy of their birth certificate there are alternate
documents which will be accepted. New Hampshire Housing will accept:
A license that contains the name and date of birth date.
A state non-driver ID.
• A federal or state generated form that shows the person's name and date of
birth.
If an applicant does not have a birth certificate or any of the alternate
documents, New Hampshire Housing will reimburse the client for the cost
incurred to obtain the birth certificate (proof of payment/receipt is required).
3 rd party verification of all assets dated within the last 60 days.
3 rd party verification of all income dated within the last 60 days.
3 rd party verification of all deductions dated within the last 60 days.

If any of the adult household members are subject to the lifetime registration under the state sex offender laws, the applicant is ineligible for assistance through New Hampshire Housing. 6/2021
