THE PROGRAM COVERS

- Past-due and future rent payments
- Utilities and heating costs
- Housing-related costs such as internet and relocation expenses
- Utility assistance even if households do not need rental assistance

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE

- If at least one person in a household has qualified for unemployment benefits, had their income reduced, had significant costs, or had other financial hardship during the pandemic
- Households at risk for homelessness, or living in unsafe or unhealthy housing
- Households that meet certain income requirements
- Whether or not households are receiving unemployment benefit payments
