2023 Low-Income Housing Tax Credit Round
Final Application Minimum Exhibit Requirements**

The following documents must be uploaded to the Apricot site no later than August 31, 2022, in order to be reviewed and scored in accordance with the 2023-2024 Qualified Allocation Plan.

Developers should upload pertinent additional exhibits at the time of application to document that threshold criteria has been met and to qualify for points. All scoring categories require supporting documentation to be submitted into Apricot.

2	Environmental information (only Floodplain/Wetland map is required at time of application)
3	Evidence of site control (<i>please note that for property that you do not yet own, the only acceptable form of site control is a purchase option if you wish to retain your project's eligibility for federal financing</i>).
8	Detailed scope of work with cost estimates and identification of estimator (this requirement may be satisfied by properly completing the application including identification of estimator and cost breakdown by construction division). Estimates must be current.
9	Verification of non-profit status (if applicable)
10	List of Developer's other real estate
11	Resumes of the Development Team (include all: developer, development consultant, architect, management agent, and any others on the team)
12	Management Agent Questionnaire (see appropriate tab on the Financing Application)
18	Schematic design plans and specifications
19	Evidence of zoning /local approval status (permit status letter)
30	Service plan and, if services are contracted, a letter of interest from proposed service provider

Applications that do not meet the above requirements will be considered incomplete.
