- Helped more than 50,000 families purchase their own homes
- Providing financing to create 16,000+ multifamily housing units

- Financed 1,800 units of multifamily rental housing



MULTIFAMILY HOUSING FUNDING

- We finance construction, acquisition and preservation of affordable rental housing for families, individuals of all ages, and people who need supportive housing services (substance use disorders, veterans, transitional)
- Developers apply for funds to construct or rehabilitate multifamily rental housing
- Funding sources include private investments through bonds and tax credits, federal grants and guarantees, state Affordable Housing Fund, and other New Hampshire Housing resources



 Direct assistance to low-income households through HUD program



- Housing Studies and Reports
- Housing Advocacy/Technical Assistance and grants
- Housing Planning Reports (state & federal)
- Conferences focused on housing issues and policies
- InvestNH Municipal Planning & Zoning Grants



INVESTNH & HOUSING OPPORTUNITY GRANTS

- Part of Governor Sununu's \$100 million InvestNH initiative
- \$5 million for grants to municipalities
- Study zoning or other regulatory causes for the lack of housing at the local level
- Update land use regulations in response to findings





HOUSING-RELATED LEGISLATIVE ACTIVITY

- **SB 145-FN -** Establishes "Housing Champion" designation for municipalities that adopt housing-friendly policies, and includes grants to incentivize participation
- SB 202 Would establish a Homeownership Innovations Fund administered by New Hampshire Housing to spur construction of starter homes
- SB 231-FN Includes appropriations for workforce and affordable housing and establishes a historic housing tax credit
- **HB 1 and HB 2 -** the State Budget for Biennium 2024-2025
