WHEREAS, Mr. Cuddy served as Vice-Chair of the Board of Directors from 2021 to 2023; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cuddy served on New Hampshire Housing's non-profit, Housing Resources of New Hampshire, Board of Trustees from 2017 to 2023; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cuddy has worked with New Hampshire Housing to respond to the unprecedented housing and economic policy issues experienced by the state related to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cuddy's efforts have supported New Hampshire Housing's mission, and that to date the agency has helped more than 50,000 families purchase a home, created over 16,000 new units of multifamily housing; and helped low-income families, senior citizens and persons with disabilities find and live in safe and decent rental housing; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Cuddy's commitment to public service has had a deep and lasting impact on ensuring New Hampshire Housing's long-term success.
