# **EDWARD PINTO, Director, American Enterprise Institute**

Pinto is a Senior Fellow and the Director of the AEI Housing Center at the American Enterprise Institute (AEI). A focus of his work is the role of federal housing policy in the 2008 mortgage and financial crisis and how federal housing policy continues to create unwelcome distortions in the housing markets. More recently his research has focused on using light touch density to increase the supply of naturally affordable and inclusionary housing. In addition, he oversees the monthly publication of the AEI Housing Market Indicators.
