Total Development Costs and Investment Limits

Current Limits:

Description	Per Unit Limit
TDC – Weighted Average	\$375,000
TDC – Weighted Average – High Cost	\$400,000
TDC (Not Weighted)	\$437,500
Investment Limit	\$300,000

- Loan Closings FY 2025
 - Average TDC/Unit: \$358,294
 - -Average TDC WA/Unit: \$318,292

- Applications for 2025 LIHTCs
 - Average TDC/Unit: \$391,501
 - Average TDC WA/Unit: \$335,892
